The minutes of the March 24, 2024, meeting were provided to the Officers and Directors. Ron Gratz made a motion, seconded by Susan Merriken, to approve the minutes as presented. Voting in favor: Cindy Ford, Ron Gratz, Susan Merriken, Sherry Patterson, Aki Pampush, Robin Sieranski, Richard Thompson, and Carla Vooris. Voting no: no one. Not voting: Beverly Garaux, Wendy Jordan, Sherry Patterson and Valerie Young. The minutes were approved.

REPORTS

Report of the President

WSSCA President Cindy Ford told the Board she wanted to give a “shout out” to everyone who worked on the 2024 National Specialty which she declared a “huge success”. All of the hard work on the part of the Board members and many other volunteers made for a great event. She reported that she had gotten a lot of positive feedback from attendees who praised the facility, trophies, banquet, and all of the Iron Welsh activities. Ms. Ford noted that she had written to the Club's liaison at Purina Farms on behalf of the Club to thank him for his help, as well as to the catering company which did a great job on the banquet.

Ms. Ford noted that in her remarks at the Annual Meeting a host club was needed for 2026 and she is hopeful that one will step up soon. To date none of the Regional Clubs have submitted proposals to host the 2026 National Specialty.

Report of the Treasurer

Susan Merriken reported that the General Fund has a current balance of \$27,267.96.

A financial summary of the National Specialty had been prepared and distributed to the board. Net of a deposit refund from Purina which was outstanding, the net cost of the National Specialty was \$1,598.45. Trophies, rosettes, and judges were the largest expense categories, offset by generous trophy sponsorships and a successful raffle and silent auction. Contributions from several regional clubs also helped off set costs.

Susan Merriken also noted that membership renewal dues notices had been sent either by mail to those who have opted out of electronic communications or by email and the initial response had been strong. As of the meeting date 88 memberships had already been renewed. Members not responding by email will be sent paper notices in the mail. Ms. Pampush added that membership renewals were put in the website “Store” and had seen some utilization. Robin Sieranski asked about membership turnover and the Treasurer said she would provide a report after the end of the fiscal year.

Starter Barks Committee Chair Robin Sieranski reported that the September issue would be focused on the National Specialty. She asked Board members who attended the National to share their experience, comments or any photos with the SB Committee to help them write the issue.

Report from the Webmaster

There was far more activity through the Store than optional mail in form. By paying a retainer the Club is able to take advantage of a substantial discount on the hourly support rate. The National Specialty product pages for the on-line Store and further work (post launch) on the member portal consumed most of the initial retainer. C. Aki Pampush made a motion to approve the application by Sandy Holmes (Trystyn Welsh Springer Spaniels) for the Limberlost Breeder of Merit Award. The supporting document identifying the 25 Champion Welsh Springer Spaniels bred or co/bred by Sandy Holmes had been submitted by Ms. Holmes and were distributed to the Board along with the Policies and Procedures related to the award. Seconded by Ron Gratz. Voting Aye: Cindy Ford, Ron Gratz, Aki Pampush, Robin Sieranski, Richard Thompson, and Carla Vooris. Voting No, no one. Abstaining, no one. D. Cindy Ford made a motion to appoint Robin Sieranski as chair of the Nominating Committee. The Committee Chair is delegated to recruit two additional committee members who are not currently either an officer or Director to nominate a slate of candidates for the following positions up for election in 2024 for terms beginning March 1, 2025:

- iii Corresponding Secretary, Carla Vooris, incumbent
- iv Member of the Board of Directors for seats currently held by Sherry Patterson, Beverly Garaux, and Valerie Young.

E. Cindy Ford made a motion to approve a recommendation by Aki Pampush for a change in the Policies and Procedures for the Puppy Litter Listings on the WSSCA website to make the policy consistent with established practice as specified in the listing request form. The change would

substitute the word “expected” for “planned” letters in section II.B, and add additional language that expected litters would not be posted more than 30 days prior to the expected whelp date. A draft of the revised policy had been submitted to the Board with the meeting materials. Seconded by Robin Sieranski. H. Aki Pampush made a motion to approve a request from the Heartland WSSC to host a Hunt Test on May 2, 2025 in conjunction with the National Specialty at the Mitford Hills Hunt Club in Jefferson Creek, Wisconsin. Lisa Juday to Chair, Aki Pampush to serve as Secretary. Seconded by Richard Thompson. Voting Aye: Cindy Ford, Ron Gratz, Aki Pampush, Robin Sieranski, Richard Thompson, and Carla Vooris. Voting No, no one. Abstaining, no one. Not voting, Beverly Garaux, Wendy Jordan, Sherry

AKC Delegate Report

The June AKC Delegate meeting was held on June 10 & 11. Due to illness, I was unable to attend the meeting. But due to the wonders of modern technology I can provide a recap of the Standing Delegate Committee meetings I would normally attend and the Delegate Meeting.

The Canine Health Committee meeting on Monday morning covered several topics: including the activities of the AKC Canine Health Foundation, the AKC Purebred Preservation Bank (semen bank), and the new CDC regulations concerning the import of dogs into the USA.

The CDC regulations are for the control of canine borne rabies. These regulations have an effective date of 08-01-2024 and have taken effect. The CDC acted to implement these regulations due to the number of dogs being imported from countries with suspect controls and regulation of rabies vaccine and prevention. These regulations, as initially developed, did not include any provisions to discern between countries with very good controls and regulations and those countries that did not. The regulations also did not account for the back-and-forth traffic of American and non-American dogs attending AKC events or events across the border in either Canada or Mexico. The AKC is still working with the CDC

to ensure minimal impact to those competing in events across the border or coming from Canada or Mexico to compete in the US and/or Americans importing a dog for their own personal use.

The AKC Purebred Preservation Bank is now functioning and accepting donations of semen. As of the presentation, 12 breeds were participating, and 19 semen donations had been made.

The Parent Club Committee meeting held in the afternoon, with Sheila Goffe, VP for Government Relations, and Charles Garvin spoke.

Sheila Goffe spoke about the new CDC regulations, the “Farm Bill” and the revised reports on the “Impact of AKC Events” by state.. These individual state reports cover the total number of AKC events held in each state, the number of exhibitors and financial impact to the state per weekend. The report also includes the number of disaster trailers donated (if any) and the number of K-9 police officers donated to individual police departments and the names of the departments. The updated reports can be found at www.akcgr.org. The reports are available in the GR toolbox function.

Farm Bill: The massive, once-every-five-year “Farm Bill” is must-pass legislation that provides billions of dollars in funding authorization for the USDA, federal food and nutrition benefits, commodities programs and other agricultural related programs. Most often it’s also a vehicle for canine legislation as well. AKC is supporting inclusion of additional resources for USDA to improve enforcement of the Animal Welfare Act, including breeder inspections; and language from the Healthy Dog Importation Act. AKC is opposing inclusion of harmful language from the Better CARE for Animals Act, the Puppy Protection Act and Goldies Act. The version of the House Farm Bill that was approved by the House Agriculture Committee contained all of AKC’s priorities, including one which would have transferred jurisdiction over animal related issues from the USDA to the DOJ (Department of Justice). Next, the U.S. Senate will its own version of the Farm Bill. AKC is seeking the same priorities for the Senate Bill.

New Dog Import Rule from CDC: The CDC published a new rule, effective August 1 that impacts how dogs can be imported into the U.S. or transported across borders. New requirements include: All dogs must appear healthy, be at least 6 months of age, be microchipped, and have a rabies vaccine from an accredited veterinarian, or be able to demonstrate that the dog has been in a low-risk country for at least 6 months. There is a link to a printable flier that provides details of this ruling. This one size fits all version of the rule contained no exceptions AKC has asked for, especially the 6-months of age puppy rule which will throw a monkey wrench into the wheels of many AKC member breeding programs. Government Relations has asked CDC to delay implementation of this part of the rule. CDC is involved in the filing of this rule because CDC deals with human health (rabies) and USDA deals with animal issues. This new rule goes into effect on August 1, 2024. Ms. Goffe suggested that anyone who has questions about these new regulations to contact either GR or the CDC to get the facts straight. There are, at this point, no exceptions even for service dogs who may have to cross the border multiple times every week. Dogs may wind up carrying passports over the border just like humans must do. Or something like a ‘known service dog’ travel permit.

The Quarterly Delegate Meeting on Tuesday the 11th had two issues to be voted on.

The first issue was the removal of term limits for individual members of the AKC Board of Directors. This amendment to Article VII, Section 1 of the Charter and Bylaws of The American Kennel Club, would remove the two consecutive term limits. This issue produced much discussion among the Delegates. My opinion was and is that the Delegate body has the power to remove any ineffective or non performing Director that runs for an additional term. Also, any individual can run by petition (from the floor) and be elected. This amendment did not pass.

The second vote was on allowing for a National Walking Gun Dog Championship for English Setters. This amendment did pass.

The following **amendments to the Rules Applying to Dog Shows** are to be voted on at the September Delegate meeting.

The proposed amendment to Chapter 9, Section 11 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows – Superintendents and Show Secretaries and Chapter 11, Section 12 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows – Dog Show Entries, Conditions of Dogs Affecting Eligibility.

The amendment to Chapter 10, Section 2 and Section 5 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows – Show Veterinarians. The owner or agent will pay the cost of any show veterinarian to examine and/or treat the dog found to be ill or injured at the show.

The amendment to Chapter 15, Section 1 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows – Protests Against Dogs, inserts that a dog remanded for examination by an event committee may only return to compete that same day, weekend, circuit, or cluster if the Show Veterinarian has examined the dog and determined its presence does not endanger other dogs.

The amendment to Chapter 14, Section 4 of the Field Trial Rules and Standard Procedure for Retrievers, will standardize the rotation and make every stake to be conducted in the same fashion when it comes to the running order.

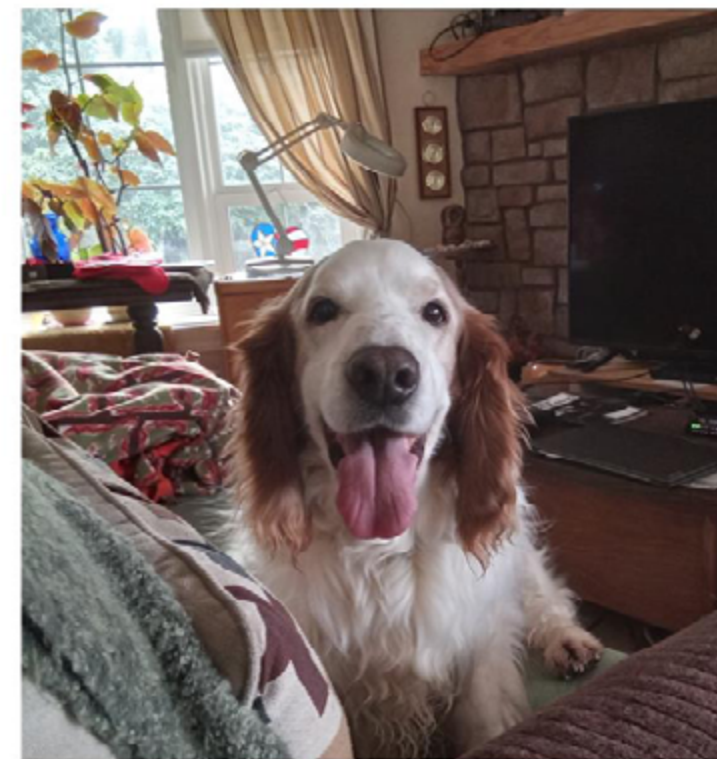

Newest Family Dog Program Sport

In February, the AKC added a new venue to its Family Dog Program: Fetch Dog. Like the other Family Dog Program activities (CGC, Star Puppy, Tricks, Therapy, Temperament Test, and Fitness), Fetch Dog is for all breeds of dogs. However, the advanced levels call for some pretty professional retrieving.

Basically, the pass-fail test shows that a dog is willing to retrieve an object and bring it to the handler. Teams that pass two tests under two different judges will earn a title. There are four levels of testing: Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, and Retriever.

In the Novice and Intermediate tests, the retrieving object may be a tennis ball or equivalent, a retrieving bumper, or a handler's choice toy (e.g., KONG Wubba). However, obedience equipment such as dumbbells or gloves are not allowed. For the Advanced and Retriever levels, toys are no longer allowed.

Each class has a standard set up which varies in size with smaller areas appropriate for the Novice level and increasing in size for subsequent levels. Tests may be outside with fencing (snow fence is allowed) or inside a building with agility matting or soft dirt.

In Novice, while the dog is by the side of the handler, the object is thrown at least 30 feet between 4 obstacles (such as boxes or laundry baskets). Once



the object lands, the dog is sent to retrieve it and must return to within 3 feet of the handler. To pass a test, the dog

must complete three retrieves. Intermediate has similar guidelines, with the object being thrown at least 50 feet and returned within 2 feet of the handler.



Advanced and Retriever get a lot trickier! Blinds are set up and helpers will place the object behind the blinds with the dog watching. Retrieves are now split into singles, doubles, and for Retriever, triples and the bumper or ball must be brought to hand. This may sound familiar to hunting Welshies who learn these skills for hunt tests.



My Welshie Twig and I participated in a Novice test in March. It was held in a person's back yard and the judges were very pleasant. I thought I could do my own throwing of the bumper and didn't do too badly, but at one point, the judge suggested she could do a better job and I was fine with that. It does make sense to practice with other people throwing for you because it is a bit different picture for the dog. There were two tests offered and handlers could run them back-to-back (6 retrieves) or wait between the two tests (3 retrieves, rest, 3 retrieves). That day I also had my Clumber Nina and a friend's Labrador participating in the tests. While all 3 dogs were successful and earned their titles, I have to admit the Labrador was the most committed to the retrieve. Twig ended up being the first Welsh to earn the Novice title.

This does seem like a fun exercise for the dog and the human and improves the "working as a team" bond. I'm sure there will be more folks deciding to hold Fetch Dog events, so check the listings on the AKC events site. For more information on the requirements, go to <https://www.akc.org/fetch/>

How to Train for Dock Diving – Told Through Our Story

Last year, while walking the venue grounds for the WSS Specialty in Louisville, Kentucky we heard a charged commotion that sounded like this: “Go! Go! GO! Gallop, gallop, gallop, gallop.....SPLASH!” Stetson (Juniper’s Peppersass), by an insistent forward pressure on the leash, let me know that his innate Welshie curiosity was on fire. Rounding a corner

Stetson’s ears shot up, his tail churned furiously, and he barked in glee. We had arrived at a pool just in time to see an exuberant dog running full speed toward the end of a carpeted dock before leaping wildly outward and upward into the sky. Its limbs gathered into a natural, streamlined tuck, the tail became a rudder, and we watched as it arced through the air before splashing into the pool in a thunderous explosion of water and spray! Bystanders were clapping and cheering. This was something new that we just had to do!

What we had just witnessed was dock diving, a competitive event sanctioned by the North American Diving Dogs (NADD), an independent governing body that hosts diving dog trials complete with earned titles that are recognized by the American Kennel Club and the Continental Kennel Club. According to their website: NADD is open for all breeds and mixes and there are divisions so that any size and age of dog can achieve excellence. Here is how the NADD describes dock diving: “Imagine a dog bounding down a dock, launching itself into the air with boundless energy, and gracefully plunging into a pool of water in pursuit of a toy or simply for the sheer thrill of the jump. That’s dock diving in a nutshell, and it’s a sight to behold!” The NADD website provides information and a list of training facilities in the United States and Canada that will enable you to join in the fun.

We found a training facility and signed up for a beginning dock diving class. At that first class I discovered that my dream of Stetson soaring unfettered over the water was not going to happen without some training! First things first – we established that Stetson was willing to enter a pool of water from a ramp and that he enjoyed swimming. After Stetson was deemed seaworthy the next step was to obtain his air endorsement. We moved to the end of the dock that is just over

a foot higher than the pool and there we stalled. While the water was, oh so tempting, the height, as perceived by Stetson, caused some doubt. How he wanted to jump! How he wanted to retrieve the toy that was tossed into the pool in front of him! The instructor, canny in the workings of the canine mind, came to the rescue. He got into the pool and started playing with Stetson’s toy. This, as far as Stetson was concerned, was behavior that needed immediate correction – Stetson jumped for his toy. Pool entry problem solved.

The NADD has standards of sportsmanship and a comprehensive set of rules and regulations on their website. The standards include the requirement that competitors always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog. The rules define divisions, titles, and classes for the canine competitors and describe entry procedures and requirements for judges, handlers, facilities, and equipment. To compete, you must first register your dog with the NADD.

In the distance-jumping competition, the dog is entitled to a “splash”. A splash consists of one optional practice jump and two jumps scored by a judge. The greater of the two scores is the qualifying score for that splash. The distance is measured from the end of the dock to the point of contact where the base of the tail (where the tail meets the body) breaks the surface of the water.

A dog’s Season Average in distance-jumping is determined by averaging the highest 15 scores in the current Season. The table below shows the distance jump divisions for the open class (what most Welshies fall under). After a division title is achieved additional titles can be earned, it does not have to be in progressive order.

Open Class	
Novice DN	1 in to 9 ft 11 in
Junior DJ	10 ft to 14 ft 11 in
Senior DS	15 ft to 19 ft 11 in
Master DM	20 ft to 23 ft 11 in
Elite DM	24 ft to 27 ft 11 in
Premier DP	28 ft and above

Stetson’s next step was to learn to run and leap. A holder would steady Stetson at the beginning of the dock while I stood at the end at the dock by the pool to call for Stetson to be released. Once running, I would toss the toy across the water for Stetson to retrieve. Stetson is very good at running and he would run like the wind across the dock! Then he would come to a screeching halt at the dock edge before he would jump into the water. He always jumped. And he always stopped before jumping. The instructor shared that this behavior was fairly common and that it usually continues until a dog has a “Eureka” moment and takes a running leap of faith from the dock for the first time. After this happens the dog has discovered that stopping is not required and is not fun.

Stetson’s “Eureka” moment came during a torrential downpour when there seemed to be more water in the air than there was in the pool. I couldn’t blink fast enough to clear my eyes to see through the rain. It also must have been that way for Stetson. As he galloped across the dock toward the pool the edge of the dock suddenly appeared. This forced Stetson to choose between leaping or ingloriously falling into the pool. He leapt and has not stopped since.

The NADD website provides a list of scheduled events for the current season. Some of the events are qualifiers for the NADD Regionals. Please note that there are two other competitions sponsored by the NADD. These are:

Air Retrieve: The NADD states that: “In this event, dogs showcase their vertical jumping ability by leaping off the dock to snatch a bumper suspended over the water at varying distances.”

Hydro Dash: The NADD states that: “Hydro Dash is a fast-paced race where dogs retrieve a toy from the 37 feet mark in the quickest time possible.”

To all of you Welshies – have fun, leap far, and splash big!

Comments from the National Specialty Judge Marjo Jaakkola



First of all, I want to say a big “Thank you” to the Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America for inviting me to judge at this prestigious event. I can honestly say it must be one of the highlights of my judging career to be able to judge at the American National Specialty. I felt very privileged to be able to judge at this top-class show. Thank you to the exhibitors entering their dogs under me and for the brilliant sportsmanship.

When I was living in Rochester, Minnesota back in 1980-1981 and had a chance then to attend my very first WSSCA National Specialty in Ludwigs Corner, PA in April 1981, some 43 years ago little did I know then that one day I would be standing in the middle of the ring judging that very same show! Dreams come true, they say.

I enjoyed every minute of it. I really liked my winners, which I found to be very typey and quality specimens of the breed. I thought they excelled in overall balance. Temperaments were excellent, only a few maybe just needed more experience in the ring, which hopefully will come with age. Some of the decisions were like splitting hair. I was able to watch the breed judging from the start till the end on Sunday and saw some dogs that were not unfortunately shown under me, who could have had a chance (judging by the ringside) to do well.

The presentation was super as expected. I found most of the dogs excelling in good breed type, some had a little tendency to look like little setters but only a few. Welsh springers should be with no exaggerations. Proportions were overall good. I did find a couple with a questionable bite, but is not a major concern. Heads were mixed, as one can expect when judging this breed.

I think the main concern, like everywhere else, is the fronts. There were several who needed more forechest and overall better fronts. I felt some needed more body and spring of rib considering their ages. Some had gay tails, which always spoils the overall picture. But it is often making compromises when judging the breed.

There were several with lovely well-ribbed bodies, good balance and pleasing movement, going around the ring with nice reach and drive. Keep the breed as a nice spaniel it is, with the look of a spaniel. They should not be over groomed, nor should they have so much hair left that it also becomes an exaggeration.

Thank you again! An experience of a lifetime.

The Welsh Springer Spaniel Outline

by Meghen Riese-Bassel

The outline of the Welsh Springer Spaniel is unique within the world of Spaniels. They are a breed that should be rectangular in appearance, with the length being created by front and rear angulation. We often describe the breed as being “a square within the rectangle”. The square is created by dropping a line from the withers to the ground and dropping a line from the tail set. The rectangle is then created by adding the front and rear angulation to that square. A Welsh Springer Spaniel cannot have a correct outline without correct angulation. Dogs who are straight in the front and rear, while balanced (and possibly moving well), lack a key part of the correct outline.

The outline is referenced three times in our breed standard, giving weight to just how important it is. To assist judges in visualizing proportions, the Welsh Springer Spaniel Club of America worked very hard to create a wonderful Illustrated Standard, available in print and on the parent club website. Within this document many questions can be answered, and the standard is expanded upon. I encourage anyone interested in judging the breed to look.

All things about the Welsh Springer should be moderate. The eye should never be drawn to a specific part of the dog. Instead, the entire dog should appear to be carved from one piece. There should be harmony amongst the pieces, and, like a puzzle, all the pieces should fit together. While they are rectangular in silhouette, they should never appear long and low. It is a delicate balance that is kept in check by a compact body and short loin. I often tell judges that if they are concerned about a dog being long and low - look at the underline. Typically, you will see a long underline on dogs that are truly long. Along the same lines, when the word compact is used in describing the Welsh Springer Spaniel it means “tightly knit”, rather than square.

I feel it is beneficial to have a comparison with other spaniel breeds when discussing Welsh Springer proportions. They are not a red and white version of the English Springer Spaniel. These are two

distinct breeds. While the two have several things in common, they have quite different outlines. A truly educated judge will be able to immediately share what those differences are. The Welsh Springer Spaniel’s outline should be rectangular. The English Springer Spaniel should be slightly longer than tall. In addition to this the Welsh Springer can often appear “relatively low-stationed”, whereas the English Springer Spaniel is described as “upstanding.” Let us also not forget that the English Springer is described as the “raciest of the British land spaniels” by multiple kennel clubs around the world. Once you begin digging, you should easily begin seeing just how different these cousins are.

“Length of body from the withers to the base of the tail is very slightly greater than the distance from the withers to the ground. This body length may be the same as the height but never shorter, thus preserving the rectangular silhouette of the Welsh Springer Spaniel.”

- Welsh Springer Spaniel AKC Breed Standard
“The length of the body (measured from point of shoulder to point of buttocks) is slightly greater than the height at the withers.”

- English Springer Spaniel AKC Breed Standard
When compared with other breeds, the Welsh Springer may seem plain. Yet, our breeders celebrate the workmanlike appearance, the athleticism, and the variety of style that exists within the realm of correct. We are thankful that the breed is unspoiled and functional!

The breed does have some interesting markings and optical illusions. When judging the Welsh Springer, especially if you come from a breed without markings, you will have to train your eye to see past the variety of markings you will encounter. Heavy ticking can cause a dog to have less bone than it does. Red markings that come past the elbow can cause a dog with a correct length of leg to appear low on leg. White spots in the middle of the back can cause a

topline to look weak when it is correct. A dog with a large amount of red can appear longer than they actually are. Undocked tails can also play tricks on the eye, causing the proportions of the dog to appear longer. I like to encourage judges to trust their hands. Additionally, most exhibitors are open to stacking their dog on the opposite side to allow you a look past what are possibly deceiving markings. It is important for the breed to retain its diversity of markings and ticking. We do not want it to become a “cookie cutter” marking breed.

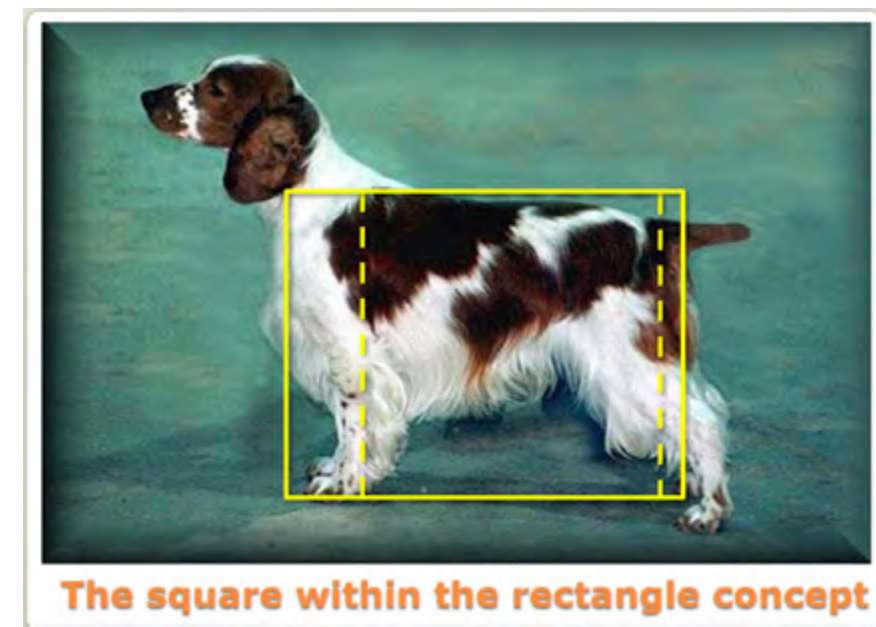
I feel it is important to discuss bone and leg length for the breed. Our bone should be of an oval shape consistent with the stamina needed to work all day. The general description states that the breed is “not leggy.” I would like to scream this from the mountaintops! The breeders have done a great job recently of keeping leg length at bay – instead producing approximately the same leg length as from the withers to the elbow.

Finally, the topline of the Welsh Springer Spaniel is level. It should not slope, roach, or dip. While the topline is level, there should be a layer of muscling over the loin on a mature dog. This is not extreme

and is typically seen with the hands rather than the eye. A puppy or young adult may not have yet developed the layer of muscling over the loin and should not be penalized. Most spaniel breeds have this muscling, giving them the curves that we associate with these breeds. One should never look at a Welsh Springer Spaniel and get the impression of a setter. Remember, the Welsh Springer Spaniel should have a rectangular outline, level topline, and should NEVER appear leggy or settery.

2024 Iron Welsh Challenge

The 2024 Iron Welsh Challenge started months before the actual competition, after the location for the National was set, and the club responsible (in this case WSSCA) we decided to welcome an Iron Welsh Competition. The number of events, the timing and location of the events, chairmen, and many other logistics get discussed and decided well ahead of time.

For 2024, Merrielle Turnbull took charge of Obedience and Rally, Donna Stebbins took charge of Agility, and I took charge of Scent Work. Beverly Graux secured the locations and kept us in line. Can you say herded us cats? The WSSCA Board coordinated the National and supported entry conformation competitions. Unfortunately, we didn't have the resources for Field or Tracking events, so we concentrated on the chosen 5. All the Iron Welsh events in 2024 were open to Welsh Springers only and very special!

12 Welshies signed up for the IWC, and we had 1 scratch. Kristi Hedges was a rock star and cataloged all the contenders and their events in a chart, in addition to an information page for each dog and our previous medal winners.

Thursday was the first day of competition for the Iron Welsh Challenge - Conformation, Obedience and Rally classes. Several of the contenders earned their participation point for Conformation. The very entertaining Obedience and Rally classes came in the afternoon with 10 contenders in Rally and 5 in Obedience. The contenders started racking up the points and impressive scores of up to 99 in Rally and several qualifying scores in Obedience. By the end of Obedience and Rally, Sully had the lead with an impressive 10 points! Just 2 points behind came Winnie, and 2 more points back with 6 each were Odie and Twig, the Veteran who came out of retirement for this Iron Welsh Challenge.

Friday the National Specialty classes were held, which are reported elsewhere in this issue. Bobby, Lainey,

and Twig placed first in their classes and were rewarded with 1 more Iron Welsh point each.

On Saturday morning, for the second time at a WSSCA National, we held Scent Work trials. And this year we included Excellent classes. Caroline Oldham was our terrific judge, even more special since she also has a Welshie! Timber, Fireside's Don't Fall For Her (lots of titles!) In addition to the qualifying awards, Caroline also gave 2 Judge's Choice awards!

Six of our Iron Welsh Contenders competed in the SW trials, 5 in Novice and Sully in Advanced. All of them earned qualifying scores in at least 1 class, earning more IW points! Welshies love to sniff – don't we all know! – so Scent Work is a great event for them. For the container searches, spectators had plenty of room, and even a picnic table. By Saturday's end, Sully was still in the lead, with Twig, Winnie, Cwen and Odie close behind.

On Sunday morning came agility. We held the **Agility Course Test**, both Standard and Jumpers. The morning was relatively cool, the ring was on lovely green grass, and the course is run OFF LEASH. Much fun was had in that ring, resulting in much laughter, much wagging, some dogs taking the ring barrier as an additional obstacle, and even 4 qualifying Scores! Qualifiers included Odie and Cwen!

Bonus points are awarded to Welshies who demonstrate versatility by qualifying in 3 or more of the events. This year, 3 qualified in 3 events each – Sully, Twig and Odie, cementing Sully's Gold, Twig's Silver, and bringing Odie up to the Bronze! Seven more earned the Iron Welsh Qualifier award – Winnie, Cwen, Ginger, Yogi, Bobby, Lainey and Rolex.

An Iron Welsh Challenge is being planned for Wisconsin in 2025. It is my favorite event of the National – why not? It includes everything! It shows how talented our Spaniels are. Who will take on the challenge? Who will be the 2025 Iron Welsh Champion?

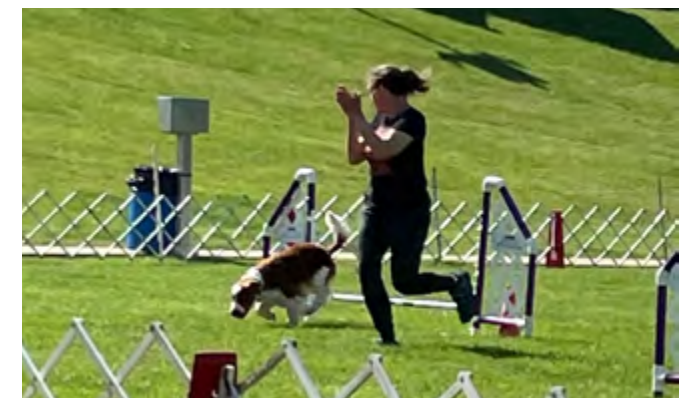

WSSCA National Scent Work Judge's Comments By Caroline Oldham

As an AKC Scent Work judge and eight year owner of my own Welsh Springer, "Timber" (Fireside's Don't Fall for Her), I was so honored to be chosen as the judge for the 2024 National Event. Timber was the first Welshie to earn AKC Scent Work titles and is still competing on the Master Level.

Scent Work is such a great fit for the natural hunting ability and energy level of the Welshie. Though Welshie's can be very independent and challenging to train in some sports, the combination of science (classic conditioning) and fun (dog is the leader, food and toy rewards can be used in the search field) is a great fit for the Welshie personality.

Like many of you, my Welshie crosstrains in many sports, many of them handler driven. When we choose to let go and simply allow the dog to hunt, success comes very easy in Scent Detection.

At the Nationals, I observed a few teams who were very proficient in Scent Detection. The dogs were well trained and the imprinting and search training they had put into their team was evident. I also observed brand new teams, who are my very favorite to watch in competition. The handlers were showing some nerves, the dogs were sometimes off task, but when the dog encountered target odor, they responded accordingly and success was had. I enjoyed so very much the surprise on the handler's face as their precious partner had made them so proud. I think we even had some tears at one point.

We worked very hard to complete two trials in just a few hours to allow plenty of grooming time that day.

The teams cooperated in that regard and the volunteers and trial secretary were some of the best I have worked with anywhere.

The gorgeous rosettes offered by the club and the Highest Scoring Welshie trophy were added incentives and obvious treasures for the teams who left with them.

If you have not tried Scent Detection with your Welshie, find a great coach who makes training fun and watch as the magic happens. There's almost no better way to use the mind and body of the dog to produce a content, satisfied and happy dog after training.

If you are continuing your journey, I hope our paths cross again. You are doing fantastic, don't give up, remember it is a process but so well worth it to participate in a sport that showcases hunting and the dog is the one in charge!

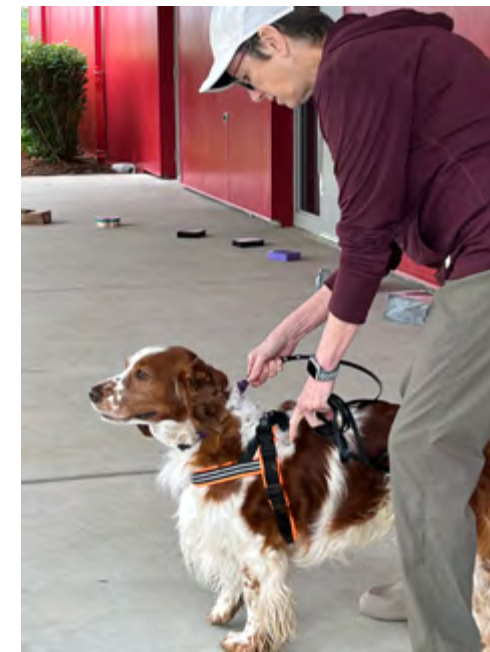

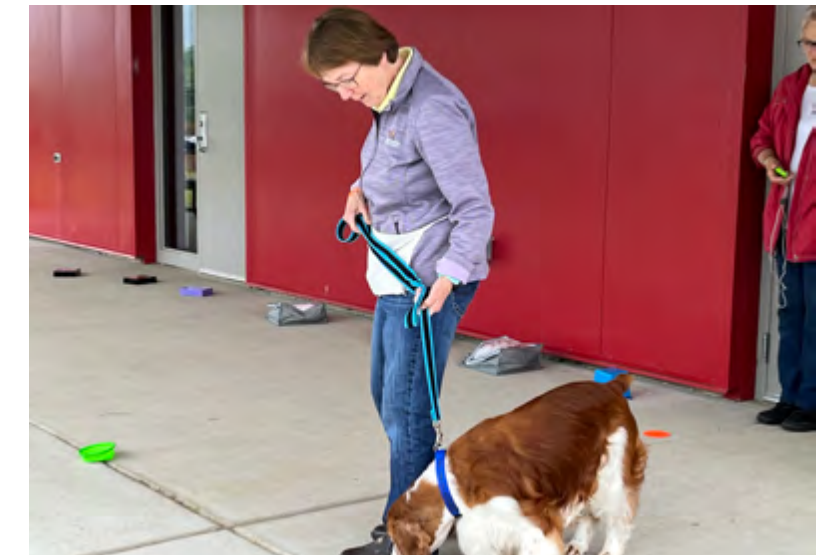

Nationals show chair Bev Garaux and I discussed the possibility of using the other club's rally trial but I wanted to offer the non-regular classes, so we decided to hold both trials as Welsh only. And it's a good thing we took that direction.

I was contacted by the Kuvasz club about joining our obedience trial and I agreed to serve as their Trial Secretary and to share our judge. The Kuvasz club had chosen to use the other club's rally trials instead of holding their own with us. Late in the process, the other club decided to not hold their rally trials, so the Kuvasz were unable to offer it for their members. So, holding our own trials really worked out for us.

What goes into holding these trials? After the date and place are chosen, you contact a judge. Happily, Jim lives near Purina Farms and he was available for our date. Then Carla Vooris put in the paperwork to AKC to get approval for our two trials. Once approved and event numbers provided, I was able to create the Premium List. Meanwhile, Aki Pampush and Mary Johnson worked on getting ribbons and trophies determined and Cindy Ford was making sure Purina knew we were needing a ring. A few reminders on the WSSCA Facebook page got folks to send in their entries and we were ready to go. The Judging Program went to AKC and entrants a week before the trial. In addition to preparing the Judge's books to record each class, I also needed to prepare the catalog, armband numbers and the sheets to show the order for each class. There is a lot of paperwork involved!

Purina had agreed to sponsor our National Specialty and included obedience and rally in the prizes they offered which included a High In Trial Pro Plan Bag. Many thanks to our WSSCA members who sponsored other prizes, including Sally Nist, Kim Laird, Ellen Hughes and I also handed out dog toys and poop bags during the day.

The day of the trials arrived and judging began. The more advanced obedience classes saw some good efforts but no qualifiers. Then we had 2 qualifiers in Graduate Novice, 2 in Novice B and 1 in Preferred Novice. The non-regular Brace team was fun to watch! **Our High In Trial was Winnie Spot of Tea BN RNI CGC TKI and Sally Nist.** This also finished Winnie's CD title. Winnie (a Tegan daughter) was returned to Sally after the death of her owner, so this was an emotional honor for Sally.

Rally saw more qualifiers and more antics! Welshies qualified in Choice, Advanced, Intermediate and Novice. While there was no one eligible for a high combined or high triple, there were many "first-timers" who did a great job. The non-regular class of Team Rally had 2 top-notch teams entered and they did not disappoint. Both teams dressed in similar attire and the dogs did a great job.

I would like to thank Cheryl Clark, Katie Lewandowski and Bev Garaux for keeping the trials running smoothly and also Cindy Rhine who stepped in to take some photographs. It really does take a village!

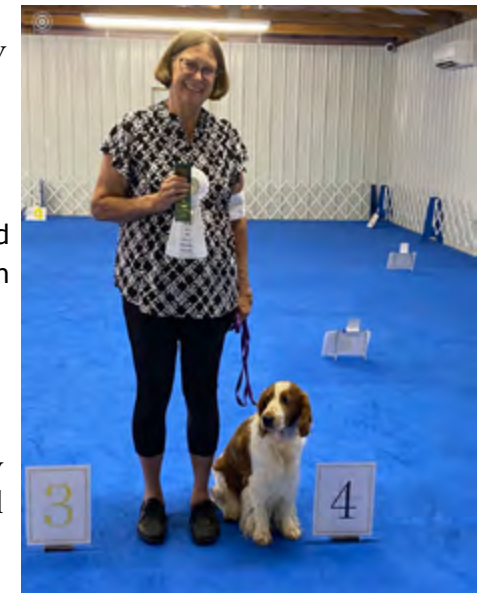

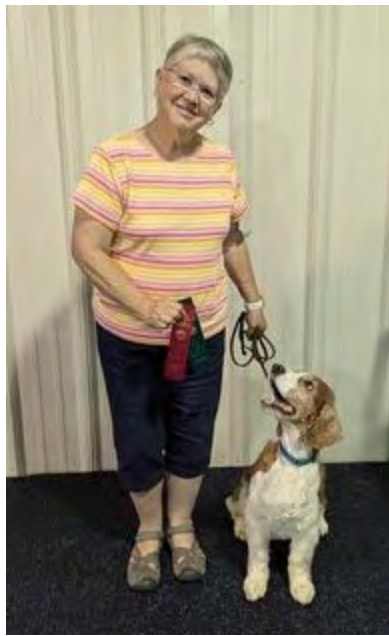
